Carma Carpooling has brought about a new way to commute. Through real-time technology, the smart phone app is able to match people with similar commute routes and schedules. From there, they arrange to carpool, sharing the cost of driving while reducing traffic congestion and emissions on the road! Their goal is to take the 900,000 empty seats that commute around Austin daily, and put them to good use.

Carma, a CLEAN AIR Force partner, came to Austin as part of a federally-

funded pilot to test the benefits of real-time carpooling and its affect on toll road use. The study is run in partnership with TxDOT, the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority, and Texas A&M Transportation Institute, and is offering 183A and Manor Expressway carpoolers up to 100% of their tolls reimbursed if they log their carpools with the mobile app.

Since the start of the program earlier this year, Carma members have driven over 12,000 miles together and taken

Carma is proud to announce that 11,100 pounds of CO₂ emissions have been avoided through shared trips so far. They have also helped 183A drivers save over \$300 through toll reimbursements.

Our special musical guest was Bill Carter of Bill Carter and the Blame. We had live and silent auctions with great prizes that helped to raise additional funds.


